Hi Kathleen,

Exciting you found our webpage!

Just so you know, this website is under continual enhancement and doesn't allow the extraction of shapefiles at this time...it also doesn't capture any telemetry information (for any species). You would be downloading a .csv of incidental observations for grizzlies mainly submitted by the public as well as some observations that were included within professionally collected datasets we consumed. This is definitely not a comprehensive dataset for grizzlies managed by IDFG. I would still talk to Wayne about any tips he might have on telemetry data.

This website is the content management system for our Species Diversity Database animals and plants minus plant EOs. The data within this website becomes the starting point for the data we share twice per year in our partner export. We haven't consumed any telemetry information at this time since it would overwhelm our database with numerous sightings of the same individual on the same day. That isn't to say we won't figure out how to consume such data in the future in a meaningful manner.

The good news is that if you create an IFWIS account using your FWS email, partner permissions will be granted to this website. This allows data downloads in .csv format. If you are not logged in, we assume you are a member of the general public and download capability is disabled. FYI, we recently filled the vacant developer position that would work on adding functionality to our /species website. I am hopeful that an ESRI format will be incorporated in the near future. To accomplish this we need to overcome some technological hurdles (which we are working on).
