Hi Betty, It don't look like we will find any data from USFS in NM. I spoke with a biologist on the Questa Ranger District and they said they it is highly unlikely that any wolverine would be around Wheeler Peak. They said the human influence there is just too great. It is the highest peak in NM and has so many people there. Plus Taos resort is there and has summer and winter activities.

They said that if any are in NM they would assume Latir Peak Wilderness would be more like it.

They said the only record they knew about was the radio collared animal that apparently came from above Colorado, then went back north. She could remember if that account was recent or historic as she heard about that wolverine when she would back in Colorado.
