Betty, Here is a quick map that shows all the locations to this point regardless of quality, but that was used to get the generic Minimum Convex Polygon (Convex Hull). The map also shows Inman's PH Model (Primary Habitat), and the Nick Hardy Composite model that combines the PH with the 7 year > 1 snow values. Nick's model from all of his data we received will not work yet, but this is the copy that the Wyoming ES office passed on.

I'm trying to down load Nick's model folder again and see if I can get it to work, as he has the PH data, the Snow model, and the stuff combined. TI think his folder will should the same final output as the composite model on this map.

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
