Thanks, I noticed Bob's records only have a year, no month associated with them. I just finished pulling the historical snow model data NOAA/CU produced for the den sites in Glacier. You'll get the details on the model this week, but what that showed was all den sites had 0.5-1.4 meters of snow depth on May 15th of the year they were documented.

Hi John, Hope all's well.

Here are the latest Dens data that includes Bob locations.

I'm sending what we are using with duplicates pulled out, with the exception of two from Bob. He had two individual ID numbers associated with one specific location. His information was limited to just the ID, XY coords and he classified the dens as "natal".

Because he had two unique ID's I actually loaded that location twice so I could retain individual records for both ID's. Your info will be duplicate there, but I need to retain both records.

Please note that the metadata is not corrected yet, but I will complete that after I get the set back from you with MODIS / elev stuff you have. Then I can resend the final if you need a copy there.

Please note we are not to distribute any of these data and we will state in the metadata that anyone requesting or trying to FOIA will have to go to the original sources.

Hope this help and we really appreciate all of your doing with the extra info.
