Wayne - The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service is currently preparing a status review for the wolverine, which includes preparing a species status assessment report that will be used to support our next listing determination (either warranted for listing or another withdrawal) under the Endangered Species Act. Our review requires that we obtain the best available information to support our evaluation of the species' status. The reference we are trying to obtain is cited in Vivian Banci's Wolverine chapter in *The Scientific Basis for Conserving Forest Carnivores: American Marten, Fisher, Lynx, and Wolverine in the United States* related to her discussion of wolverine foraging behavior. We are trying to locate the original citation from that section (i.e., Knorre 1959) to confirm the information presented by Banci.
