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Information on M-56 wolverine wonderer that moved from Colorado, Montana, and shot in North Dakota by rancher Jared Hatter on April 24, 2016. Based on information that we found on the internet, the USFWS Carlsbad field office made assumptions to the general location and then made contact with Stephanie Tucker, furbearer biologist for the North Dakota Game and Fish's Wildlife Division, Bismarck. Stephanie was able to provide account of kill and the latitude, longitude midpoint of Township/Range; T148N R102W that represents the kill location. This location is in a pasture on a ranch and could be the ranch that Mr. Hatter works.

The data location for M-56 kill was input using the provided coordinates; Lat 47.640071, Long - 103.640842. Coordinates were entered into an excel sheet, and then converted into GIS point location using the ArcCatalog, create feature calls from XY. Once this process was, complete we projected the location to the Wolverine Range-wide Albers that we are using for all data and this location was merged into the overall location data. This location also resides in it complete source file with information about location and source.
