Wolverine to do: 2/24/17

Snow/Slope

1. Run middle of the road year (TBD) for Glacier, similar to process for 2005 and 2011. Talk to NOAA first.
2. Pull DEMs for all den sites in lower 48 and calculate slope in proximity to dens.
3. Integrate Glacier DEM/slope with 2005 worst case scenario projection to look at snow distribution relative to slope, elevation and den site location.

Canada:

1. Obtain all wolverine occurrence and den site locations.
2. Obtain spatial data for historical trapping take in proximity to the US/Canada border.

Range:

1. Work with Ed and Betty to determine current range in the lower 48.
2. Obtain occurrence records for Wyoming.

Misc:
