Wayne - Here is the sentence citing Knorre 1959 (from Banci 1994: Wolverine in *The scientific basis for conserving forest carnivores*; USDA Forest Service General Technical Report, RM-254, page 113):

Because of their low foot loads (pressure applied to substrate) of 22 g/cm² (**Knorre 1959**), wolverines can prey on larger mammals in deep snow and when ungulates are vulnerable.
