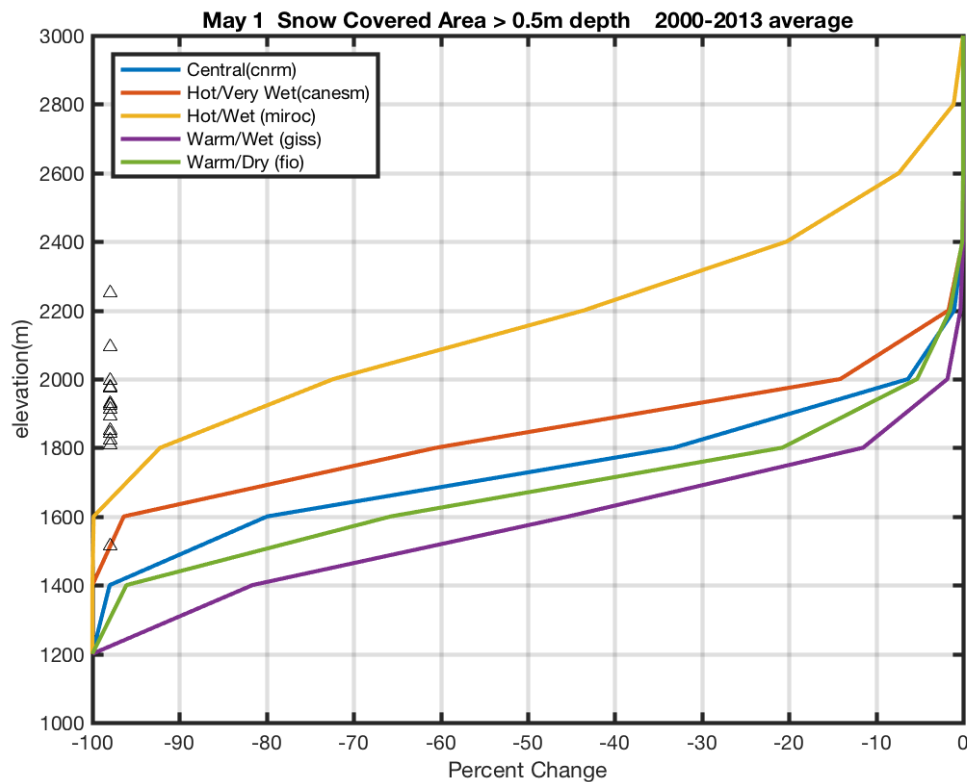
What are the units for the the rasters you created for this graph that are sitting in the shared drive? Rasters are here:
