This letter is in regard to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, dated October 31, 2019 and assigned tracking number FOIA FWS-2020-00098 for the following:

“All documents and information related to the Service’s preparation of a final SSA for wolverine. This includes, but is not limited to, all inter-agency and intra-agency communications (including correspondence with state wildlife agencies) including letters, emails, phone records, phone logs, meeting notes, memos, white papers, policy papers, and any other documents or information (and drafts of such documents and information) related to the final SSA for wolverine.”

This is the seventh interim response to your request. For this response, we have enclosed two-hundred ninety-three (293) documents (2,301 pages) and twenty-four (24) shapefiles (20,416KB) which are being released to you in their entirety. We are continuing to review additional records that are responsive to your request.

As provided in our December 13, 2019, letter to you, you may file an appeal regarding our delay in making a final determination on your request. We apologize for this delay. We hope that you will wait so that we can complete our review process.
