Tiernan,

Here are the shape files for the Braxton County property we discussed as possible bat habitat mitigation for MVP. There is an existing 8' wide rough dirt ATV path. The adjacent landowner would like to repair some slips and upgrade the existing access for more than ATV use (not to exceed 20'). He would like the easement to provide access to the west side of his property, which is currently only accessible by walking over the mountain. MVP would specify the terms of the easement and we can limit the easement conditions and usage as necessary. A sketch of the existing access on the property is shown in red on the attached png file.

For purposes of determining whether this is suitable for bat mitigation can you confirm what level of detail you need on the existing habitat?
