Tiernan/Liz: Janet just called - she has a mussel survey request for Mountain Valley Pipeline. The info she has says that they also sent the request to this office. She had 2 concerns 1) the project crosses South Fork Potts Creek and she would like to get them to avoid crossing that stream (James spiny mussel there) and 2) whether the project should be relocating mussels yet. The survey request wants to relocate mussels now, but I didn't think they were far enough along in the permitting process to do that. Please let me know which one of you has this request and then let me know where you are with the review. We too should be recommending avoiding South Fork Potts.
