We've been talking about the ACP but I realized we haven't coordinated recently on the MVP. They didn't capture Ibats during their survey, just NLEB. They tracked 1 lactating female bat to a roost tree so we've 1 maternal roost tree and I likely have a previously unidentified NLEB hib that they're crossing. In terms of bats those are my only issue now that the final 4(d) is published. How are you planning on handling the bat issue in WV and what did they capture in their surveys?
