Hi Barb,

It was good to see you again last week. During our meeting with Tiernan, it was discussed that it may be best for MVP to come back to your office and meet with the two of you to go over the requirements for a Formal Consultation Biological Assessment. I know Tiernan is out but I also know how quickly your schedule fills up. I wanted to get this request in front of you sooner than later. Could you please let me know if/when you have an hour to discuss the BA requirements with our team? We are planning to file our application with FERC in early/mid-October. Any information you could provide prior to that time would be very helpful. I have included a few questions below that will help us get a document started and prepare for our meeting.

Do you anticipate USFWS Gloucester and Elkins issuing one concurrence or separate? This will frame how we prepare the document (s)

With a 300 mile Project (approximately 200 miles and 3,000 acres in WV) do you see a situation in which we would be able to remain in informal consultation?

Do you have an example BA that we should be using as a reference?

We have completed netting and are finishing up portal searches. Do we need to complete detailed habitat assessments for the entire Project as well?
