Twelve Days of Accountability

For 12 days beginning mid-December the Dominion Pipeline Monitoring Coalition is submitting Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) requests to Virginia officials and agencies for information related to pipeline construction. With regulatory approvals for both the ACP AND MVP proposals seemingly on the fast track for the coming year, we are alarmed by the lack of state agency engagement and by apparent political interference. The Twelve Days of Accountability is an information-gathering prelude to a pending challenge to federal reliance on Virginia's implementation of Clean Water Act requirements.
