To clarify the email below, MVP acquired the 121-acre property in Braxton County referenced in the Biological Assessment. MVP is currently not pursuing a detailed habitat assessment of the site; however, MVP will protect the property in perpetuity through a conservation easement as part of the voluntary conservation measures for the MVP project.

Sumalee,

We do not have a particular site chosen. In the voluntary conservation measures section of the BA we suggested two measures for bat mitigation:

1. A site in Braxton County, WV, but Tiernan wanted more information (such as a detailed habitat assessment) before accepting that site for bat mitigation. Due to her uncertainty we are not pursuing that site at this time.
2. MVP will work with state agencies in West Virginia and Virginia to identify opportunities for enhancement to public lands including wildlife management areas or preserves. For this measure MVP is using the HEA model to provide funding for bat mitigation derived from the quantity of service acres translated into dollars, with inclusion of a typical land management multiplier. We are pursuing this measure with each, but chosen sites will likely be at their discretion.
