I was looking at FERC's BA and noticed that they removed a lot of the detail from the *Description of the Proposed Action* Section. The previous version of the BA from EQT had much more detail. I quickly scanned the FEIS and the level of detail that we need appears to be in that document. So we could either use the project description in the FEIS, to develop our deconstruction and effects of the action table, or request that FERC send us the previous project description (from EQT's BA) as supplemental information. Let me know what you think. I'll be around all day.
