I heard back from Robyn, and her response was that they have not considered negative surveys a LAA. So for MVP I recommend we move forward using a negative survey as the basis for a NLAA. I checked the ACP BO and none of the Ibat T&C or Monitoring Requirements were geared towards the impacts to "unoccupied suitable summer habitat" so ACP wouldn't have any undue burden placed on them from taking this approach to our analysis.
