Hi Jordan,

Is this ok for candy darter:

The court ordered deadline for the 12-month finding for listing determination of candy darter is September 30, 2017. There are known occurrences of candy darter in Stony Creek and the proposed route parallels the creek for ~1 mile and crosses the creek. The sedimentation action area shape file indicates sedimentation effects to the creek, including both up- and down-stream of the proposed crossing. We appreciate including a time of year restriction (TOYR) for in-stream construction in Stony Creek of August 15-July 31, which includes a recommended TOYR of April 15-July 15 for candy darter. We recommend including additional avoidance and minimization measures of fish relocation behind cofferdams and implementing enhanced sediment and control measures.
