Hi all,

I spoke to Megan Stahl today and she clarified that the information to be provided in the E&S plans and SWPP should be similar in content to FERC's 2013 Upland Erosion Control, Revegetation, and Maintenance Plan and MVP's Restoration and Rehabilitation Plan. The POD for the Jefferson National Forest is thousands of pages and she indicated the main points of interest are discussed in the FEIS. So I told her we did not need to see those documents. She will still send their invasive species management plan.

Also, she indicated that although they plan to implement FERC's recommendation of HDD at Pigg River, they would prefer us to be conservative and still assume dry cut crossing, in case they start to drill and find out that they can't do it. So, we'll need to remove the row with HDD from the effects table.

In the Restoration and Rehabilitation Plan, on pg 7, they indicated that they will also use woody seed mix to revegetate temporary workspaces and access roads within impacted forested areas. I asked her if the temporary workspace included the temporary construction ROW, and she said yes.

I can ask Megan if there is other additional information in the E&S plans and SWPP that would be additional AMMs. If not, we probably don't need to see it, but I also wouldn't cite them as AMMs in the BO unless we can set eyes on them.
