Hi Judy,

I hope all is well with you.

I wanted to catch up with you on MVP. In an October filing, Mountain Valley was pleased to incorporate changes to our proposed route largely in response to stakeholder feedback. The newly proposed route incorporates the Mount Tabor Variation, which would thus avoid impacts to The Nature Conservancy's Blake Preserve. The transmittal letter for the proposed route filing highlighting this is attached for your reference.

Please also note that the comment period for the Draft Environmental Impact Statement extends through December, so there is an opportunity to comment on this positive change to demonstrate The Nature Conservancy's position on route preferences and other comments/concerns to FERC.

I also wanted to let you know that I have been partially out-of-pocket lately because I accepted a new position within NextEra in our Operations Department and have been getting up to speed quickly. As a result, I will no longer be working on Mountain Valley, but I am leaving it in good hands with Jena Mier and Lindsey Hesch (copied here).
