Hi Sumalee,

For the MVP project we are currently finalizing the proposed clearing schedule for the project, by milepost, as necessary for the Take Analysis in the Biological Assessment. Inevitably there are some areas, most notably condemnation tracts, where it is unlikely we will be able to gain access to clear trees until mid-2018. Bat mist net surveys were completed for the project during summer 2015. Thus, 3 years will have elapsed in August 2018. What can be done after that time to remain in compliance with ESA for tracts that need to be cleared in late summer / early autumn 2018? Can we clear the remaining tracts when the winter tree clearing window opens again in November 2018, or is it possible to mist net remaining tracts during the summer of 2018? Your input is greatly appreciated.
