Sometime late next week I will need to provide an update on the fisher population for the Southern Oregon Cascades population to the larger group I am working with to meet our April 7 deadline to publish a final decision on fisher. Would you be so kind as to send me a few sentences on what you know from your hair snare/camera data and the telemetry study? For example, how many individuals do you have identified, what are the genetics of the animals, any thoughts on whether this population is expanding that you would share for the record?
