

**AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO
THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN

This Amendment No. 1 (“Amendment”) to the August 30, 2017, Forest Fuels Reduction and Species Conservation in California Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) is made as of the date of last signature below (“Effective Date”) by and between Sierra Pacific Industries, hereinafter referred to as “SPI,” California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection, hereinafter referred to as “CAL FIRE,” the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation, hereinafter referred to as “NFWF,” and the United States Department of Agriculture (“USDA”), Forest Service, Pacific Southwest Region, hereinafter referred to as the “U.S. Forest Service.”

1. COMMENCEMENT/EXPIRATION DATE

The current expiration date of the MOU is December 31, 2019. The undersigned agree to extend the expiration date of the MOU for a period of five (5) years. The new expiration date of the MOU shall now be December 31, 2024. This new expiration date may be extended with the further agreement of all of the parties. All other terms of the MOU shall remain unchanged.

2. COUNTERPARTS

This Amendment may be executed in counterparts, each of which, irrespective of the date it is executed and delivered, is considered an original. These counterparts together constitute the same instrument.




