Hi Elizabeth

This came in from Green Diamond. It's not a verifiable sighting, but wanted to share with you. Also wanted to do a cyber introduction between you and Frank Weaver, who is a recent hire in our Roseburg office. We are transitioning the fisher CCAA work to him.

Frank, Elizabeth is a biologist in our Klamath Falls office. She's been that office's representative on the fisher listing team and is well-versed in fisher happenings (and spotted owl, and . . .) in the south-eastern Oregon Cascades area. The Klamath basin portion of Oregon is under the jurisdiction of the Sacramento RO, so the Green Diamond lands enrolled under the Oregon fisher CCAA are technically in their wheelhouse. However, for this particular project, the K-Falls office has let us take it on. But Elizabeth would be the person to keep in the loop for CCAA actions in her area (pretty much Green Diamond, as I think all of the other enrollees are west of the Cascade crest).

Hello,

In compliance with GDRCo's Fisher CCAA we are required to report any fisher observations by our staff within 3 working days. On Friday March 20, 2020, Justin Kostick (District Forester) was driving on Hwy 66 west of Keno, OR and observed a fisher cross Hwy 66 traveling South. I have provided a GPS location of the observation and a georeferenced PDF map. The date, time, and observer data is located in the attribute table of the shapefile.
