Hi Jenny and Mike: Meghan said you were asking her about the fisher comms and talking points?

We developed FAQs for this outreach, not TPTs, which were sent to YFWO mid-March. Gina reviewed and supplied edits which were sent to HQ and we have yet to hear/see anything final from them. I'm attaching the most recent version here, but this is still DRAFT. There are a few comments that haven't been addressed yet.

Since Yreka FWO is the lead office, I've been coordinating the outreach for this package. The SacFWO and Reno FWO will handle a portion of the outreach to contacts within their areas of coverage.

There is no publish date for the rule, only that it has to be delivered to FR on or before April 25. Best guess is that it will publish at the earliest the week after, but more likely the first week of May.

Please let me know if you need anything else on this, and I'll let you know as soon as I hear any movement on this from HQ.
