Hello Gina, Hope all's well with you and your family. This week I put together any of my emails that may be related to the Records request. Not emails about us trying to decide on map colors and such, but emails about data questions, ownership, table questions, etc. and I provided all that to Heidi so she has it for record.

On the data, we exchanged the NCSO/SSN units data back at Christmas time as the unit names/numbers adjusted, but the other data I could think you'd wish to have would be the Considered Exclusions and the ownership I was building.

The exclusions are based on all the data that was passed down by you or Laura, and the ownership is based on what Shaughn and I were talking about at the time. It was a combo of the latest BLM-SMA general ownership, then combined in the Wilderness Areas and National Monuments (Shaughn was still looking for one and can't truly remember it though), finally I combined in the CalFire 2018 ownership as we discussed that being better for CA areas. I kind of left it at that point as there was question about true owners when BLM and CalFire didn't match, but you were on detail in DC and I got pulled on to other stuff.
