Thank you very much for the reply.

Inyo NF has fisher listed as a species of concern on their website, and Reno overlaid a GIS map of their area of coverage on the fisher rule range map. It shows a small portion on east side of NCSO range in Lassen co, and a strip of SSN dps from the Sierra crest down the east side, from Yosemite south through SeKi NP to northeast of Bksfld in Seq NF land, then back up west and north of Death Valley.

So its why they were asking. They will do outreach to federal, state, NGO and local stakeholders in Inyo and Mono counties, all others done by SFWO/Meghan and myself/YFWO, and OFWO.

Hi Dan - we are ready to roll on the fisher final rule publish and outreach, but Reno FWO is concerned that the range map in the rule goes into Inyo and Mono counties, under their jurisdiction. I have no outreach contacts for that area, or even a mention of those counties in the actual rule language and range description for the SSN.

Should we include Inyo and Mono in our outreach, which falls to the Reno office?

The map included in the rule and the QAs is somewhat vague with a wide sharpie like line on the Sierra crest down south to Kern co.
