Space Exploration Technologies, Corp. (SpaceX) has revoked the closure date of February 27, 2020 at the company's site located near Boca Chica Beach, Cameron County, Texas.

SpaceX is planning to conduct systems testing on Saturday, February 29, 2020 at the company's site located near Boca Chica Beach, Cameron County, Texas. The window for testing will be from 2 am to 6 am. Approved backup dates are: Sunday, March 1 from 2 to 6am and Monday, March 2 from 12 midnight to 4 am if needed.

As required for these activities, SpaceX will establish a safety zone perimeter in coordination with local law enforcement that will include temporary closures of Highway 4 and Boca Chica Beach. Cameron County has established a hotline for road closure updates at 956-548-9541, and public notices will also be available online at [www.co.cameron.tx.us](http://www.co.cameron.tx.us)
