Program Descriptions

Open-air Tram Tour

\$10 per adult. Children 12 and under free with one or more paying adults. Tram seating is limited. To guarantee your tram seats, you must register ahead of time. Join us for a trip around the refuge and learn about the wild lands and wildlife. Bring your binoculars and camera! Drinking water and insect repellent are also recommended. The program will occur except with lightning, heavy wind or rain, or impassable road conditions. Dress for the weather! Meet at Creef Cut Wildlife Trail parking lot, Hwy 64 and Milltail Road, app. 6 miles west of Manns Harbor. Call 252-216-9464 for reservations.

Pea Island Bird Walk

FREE - Pea Island is for the birds - actually! Throughout the year, Pea Island National Wildlife Refuge has close to 400 species of birds live here or pass through. Whether you're a beginner or an expert, you'll enjoy this casual stroll beside North Pond. Field guides, binoculars, sunscreen, and insect repellent are recommended. Some field guides and binoculars will be available for loan. Meet at Pea Island National Wildlife Refuge Visitor Center, app. 4 miles south of Basnight (Oregon Inlet) Bridge, Hwy 12.
