Special Reminders...

- All hunters with disabilities must possess a Class A or C Hunting permit to be eligible to hunt in this special hunt.
- All hunting participants are required to have a Refuge Permit, a valid Wisconsin small game license, and State & Federal stamps.
- Hunting from a hand powered boat or boat with an electric motor will be allowed. A small boat may be used to set decoys and retrieve birds. Hunters should be considerate to other hunters.
- This hunt is limited to 14 participants/day. If more than 14 applications are received by the deadline, then a random drawing will be held for each day.
- Please fill out the enclosed application and return it to the Refuge by October 3, 2022.

Privacy Act Statement

Authority: The information requested is authorized by the National Wildlife Refuge System Administration Act (16 U.S.C. 668dd-ee) as amended and the Refuge Recreation Act (16 U.S.C. 460k – 460k-4, 640K-3, & 664).

Purpose: The collection of personal information is to verify that an individual is eligible to receive a permit to conduct monitored activity on areas within the National Wildlife Refuge System, national fish hatcheries, and other conservation areas administered by the Secretary of the Interior for fish and wildlife purposes.
