Follow instructions in the refuge hunt publication; not all fields may be required. Read and comply with all refuge regulations, including application deadlines. **This is a lottery hunt. Chosen hunters are required to pay a \$15.00 user fee by Nov. 2 to receive their permit. Do not send the fee with the application.** Mail applications to Las Vegas NWR headquarters. You will be notified by email or letter if you are selected, and you may call after October 16th for confirmation. The refuge provides each hunt group with a blind. Hunters are assigned one of six blinds on October 16th, then the user fee is due. The blinds are four-foot-deep pits with a moveable camouflage cover. Occasionally pop-up blinds are substituted for management or accessibility reasons.

Applications must be postmarked by October 1, 2023, permits for the lottery will be drawn on October 16, 2023

Hunt blinds are located a ¼ to ½ mile walk from the parking areas. Hunters possessing a Handicapped Hunting License or Mobility Impaired Card that require a reasonable accommodation in order to participate in the hunt should contact the refuge manager prior to arrival. Hunters must check-in prior to hunting, preferably before sunrise, attend a mandatory orientation, and checkout by 1:30 p.m. at refuge headquarters. PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT

Authority: The information requested is authorized by the National Wildlife Refuge System Administration Act (16 U.S.C. 668dd-ee) as amended and the Refuge Recreation Act (16 U.S.C. 460k – 460k-4, 640K-3, & 664).

Purpose: The collection of personal information is to verify that an individual is eligible to receive a permit to conduct monitored activity on areas within the National Wildlife Refuge System, national fish hatcheries, and other conservation areas administered by the Secretary of the Interior for fish and wildlife purposes.
