Hi Barb. Lately I've been preoccupied with the other MT RMP BAs, but had actually just remembered to look at this one early this morning (was in a meeting when you called..). Sorry for the delay and thanks much for the follow-up. The letter looks really good to me. Nice job!

Something I noticed when perusing the BA was that on the figure for lynx CH (Fig 13, p. 157), it shows "proposed" CH, but actually all CH designations were finalized in September 2014. So technically that figure isn't correct - but materially it doesn't affect the effect determination since CH is still outside the GRSG habitats. Do you think that's worth briefly noting in our letter, or should BLM/FS maybe just do an errata sheet with the corrected map? Might be wise to just tie that off somehow. Thanks,
