The attached draft report (sent as two documents) was prepared to provide an overview of the comprehensive, landscape-level strategy for conservation of the greater sage-grouse developed by the BLM and USFS.

The draft report details specific proposed planning decisions and management actions to be implemented upon completion of the plan RODs and, in the case of non-LUP management actions, are already being implemented.

This draft report is intended to summarize how the proposed LUPs and associated management actions address the two factors which led to the FWS finding of "warranted but precluded" and, specifically, how proposed LUP decisions and related management actions address each of the threats identified in the COT report and would provide regulatory certainty.

The report was prepared by ASLM, BLM, and USFS staff.
