

RD briefing, CCP

1. CCP finalized in 2008
2. Colorado Package = recent compilation of actions taken to implement plan
3. Implementation of plan is voluntary, so progress has been slow
 - a. Most success perhaps in:
 - i. Raised awareness of stakeholders (e.g., Tri-State siting away from leks)
 - ii. Conservation easements for wildlife habitat.
 - iii. PJ removal & habitat improvements
 - iv. Removal of worst routes for TWE & EGS
 - v. CCP effort may have helped fuel revision of the COGCC rules to be more wildlife friendly
 - b. Least success in – curtailing housing? Affecting grazing?
4. COGCC O&G rules are not voluntary—must consult with CPW—but outcome depends on landowner, industry, and COGCC.
5. Recommended ways to improve
 - a. Reporting
 - b. Protection on state lands (probably)(Grazing, oil & gas, ...)
 - c. Perhaps more protection & mitigation required by COGCC
 - d. Finalize Colorado Habitat Exchange process
 - e. Protection on private lands (zoning incentives, CCAA,
