Good Afternoon-

We're planning to hold our analysis meetings for the greater sage-grouse status review this spring. Due to some shifts in our schedule, we have revised our timeline and the timing of these meetings. The analysis meetings were originally going to be two separate meetings (May 4-8 and May 18-22). Given the timeline shifts, it was decided that we should use the May 4-8, 2015 week for technical work with a small group including our species leads and condense the discussion of material and decision recommendation formulation into one meeting later in the month (May 26 - June 5). In order to make these meeting efficient, we are constraining our invitation list; the entire FMT will not be required to attend.
