

Colorado State Land Board
Stewardship Trust

The Stewardship Trust serves to protect the long-term productivity and sound stewardship of lands held in trust by the Board. The Stewardship Trust is a living entity. When Board members vote to remove a parcel from the Trust, the Board must replace it with an equal or greater-sized parcel, so that the Trust always contains 295,000-300,000 acres. After two rounds of nominations and designations (1998 and 2000), and adjustments in 2004, 2006, 2007 and 2009, the Trust now consists of 296,183.47 acres across 113 separate parcels.
