VALLEY CITY, ND – The Valley City Wetland Management District (WMD) will be opening six different units to cattle grazing; Fingal, Hagglund, and Sortland WPAs in Barnes County, Eberle, Graving, & Evers WPAs in Griggs County.

The six units will be allocated using a competitive bidding process. The grazing agreements will be multiple year agreements. Each unit is unique in size and each agreement has different conditions. Therefore, please review the Special Terms and Conditions for each unit for more detailed information. You will be responsible for maintaining and repairing permanent boundary fence and possibly building any temporary fencing that might be needed.

later than 1:00 p.m. on March 21, 2022 and will be opened at 1:00 p.m. that day. If you plan to bid on multiple units please fill out a bid sheet for each unit. No phone bids will be accepted. The public is welcome to attend the opening at 1:00 p.m. in the office.
