Global Rank: G1: Critically Imperiled - At very high risk of extinction due to extreme rarity (often 5 or fewer populations), very steep declines, or other factors.

G2: Imperiled - At high risk of extinction or elimination due to very restricted range, very few populations, steep declines, or other factors.

G3: Vulnerable - At moderate risk of extinction or elimination due to a restricted range, relatively few populations, recent and widespread declines, or other factors.

G4: Apparently Secure - Uncommon but not rare; some cause for long-term concern due to declines or other factors.

G5: Secure - Common; widespread and abundant.

GH: Possibly Extinct - Known from only historical occurrences but still some hope of rediscovery. There is evidence that the species may be extinct, but it is uncertain.

Species Status: E: Endangered - Defined as a species that is in danger of extinction throughout all or a significant portion of its range.

T: Threatened - Defined as a species that is likely to become endangered within the foreseeable future.

SC: Species of Concern - A species or subspecies which might become threatened under continued or increased stress. Also, a species or subspecies for which there is some concern, but for which information is insufficient to permit an adequate status evaluation. This is not a legal category.

SI: Species of Interest - A species with low population levels within the state, but not considered imperiled due to naturally low habitat quantities or location on the edge of the natural species range.

EX: Extirpated - A species or subspecies that occurred in the state at the time of European settlement and that has since disappeared from the state.

H: Historic - A species documented in the state, but not observed reliably in 20 years, though not considered extinct or extirpated.
