Responsibilities:

- Works with foreign counterparts to ensure imports have been tested and found not to contain specific viruses and pathogens.
- Certifies the aquatic animal health inspector, in the country of import origin, using the Title 50 Certifying Official Form (FWS Form 3-2273). This inspector performs and signs the U.S. Title 50 Certification Form (FWS Form 3-2274), which is a fish health certificate.
- Receives the Title 50 Importation Request Form (FWS Form 3-2275).
- Evaluates the fish health certificate.
- Issues an official "Letter of Authorization" to the importer.

- Issues U.S. Import/Export License (FWS Form 3-200-3).
- Issues a **Designated Port Exemption Permit** (FWS Form 3-200-2)
- Processes the Import/Export Declaration Package.
- Approves, or denies, the importation request at the designated Service port of entry.
