



SUMMER JOB FOR TEENS



Kodiak Refuge Youth Conservation Corps (YCC)

To apply: Application must be received by Monday April 4th, 5pm.
Employment Period: Part time, running approximately June 13-August 12th
Hours: Part time job varying from 12-40 hours per week. Most work will take place on the Kodiak road system with two possible trips in the field that will both be five days in length.
 All local, state and federal workplace policies must be followed.



Some examples of duties/learning opportunities:

- Training on environmental conservation issues
- Education about the Kodiak Refuge
- Trail maintenance, marine debris clean ups
- Assisting with youth programs
- Training in CPR/First Aid, bear safety and more.

To be eligible for the Youth Conservation Corps, applicants must:

1. 15 – 18 years of age for duration of employment.
2. Wear the YCC uniform in a neat, clean manner.
3. Have housing in the community of Kodiak.
4. Be prepared to work outdoors on rainy days and indoors on sunny days – it happens.
5. Have transportation to and from work, primarily meeting at the Kodiak Refuge Visitor Center.

How to Apply:

- Submit a completed application form by the deadline. Applications are available at the Kodiak Job Services Center, in the tote at the front door of the Kodiak Refuge Visitor Center (402 Center Avenue) and on our website (<https://www.fws.gov/refuge/kodiak/>).
