

West Entrance to Swan Lake Canoe Trails has parking area with toilets and trailhead register. Portage to and paddle across Canoe Lake #1, #2, and #3, Contact, Marten, Spruce, Otter, Duckbill, Weasel, Big Mink, and Little Mink lakes to Camp Island Lake. Swan Lake Canoe Area is designated wilderness. No motorized equipment or vehicles. Please pack out litter.
