Paddle across Portage Lake, then portage to and paddle across Birch, Teal, Mallard, Raven, Swan, and Loon lakes to Clam Lake. Alternate route from West Entrance to Swan Lake Canoe Trails, starting at Canoe Lake #1. Swan Lake Canoe Area is designated wilderness. No motorized equipment or vehicles. Please pack out litter.
