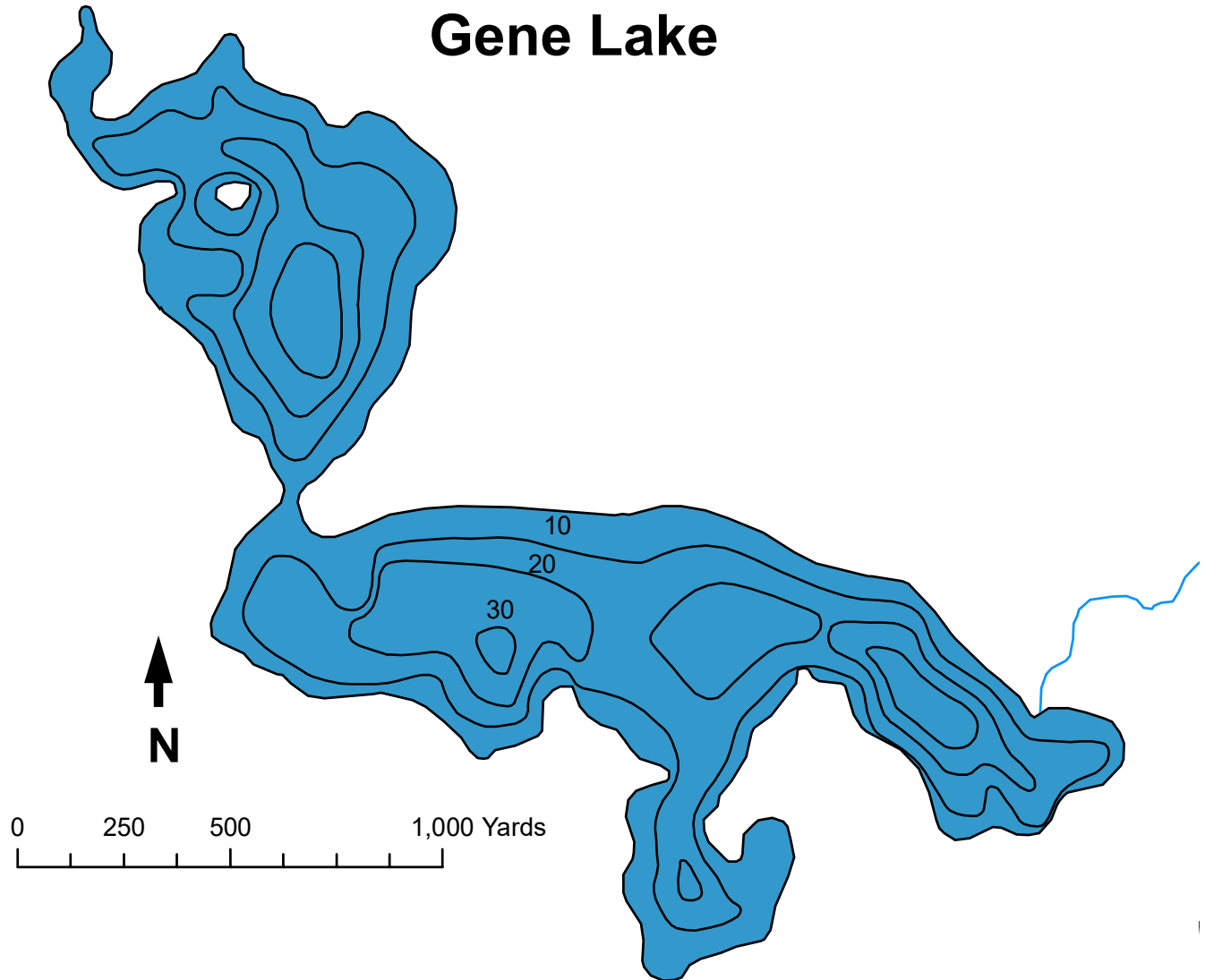

Portage to and paddle across Paddle, Lure, Pot, MJ's, Pond, Balloon, Lonely, Kuviak, Junco, Lost, Red Squirrel, Woods, and Gene lakes. Alternate route: from Kuviak Lake, portage to and paddle across Redpoll, Berry, Campers, Swanson, and Gene lakes. Swanson River Canoe Area is designated wilderness. No motorized equipment or vehicles. Please pack out litter.
