

Lake Public Access: Mile 83.4 Sterling Hwy, 16 miles north on Swanson River Road, 12 miles east on Swan Lake Road. Parking area at end of road with toilets and trailhead register. Portage to and paddle across Paddle, Lure, Pot, Pond, Lonely, Kuviaak, Junco, Lost, Red Squirrel, Woods, Gene, Eider, Olsjold, Wonder, Wilderness, and King Lakes. Swanson River Canoe Area is designated wilderness. Please pack out litter. Lake open to aircraft.
