

<u>Lake Public Access:</u> Mile 52.7 Sterling Hwy, 1 mile southwest on Schooner Bend, 2.6 miles south on Russian Lakes Trail. At end of Schooner Bend is Russian River Campground with 83 RV-suitable campsites, tables, firepits, water, toilets, dump station, fish cleaning stations, there is a fee, and a privately-owned ferry carries passengers to opposite bank and mouth of Russian River. Lake open to aircraft.
