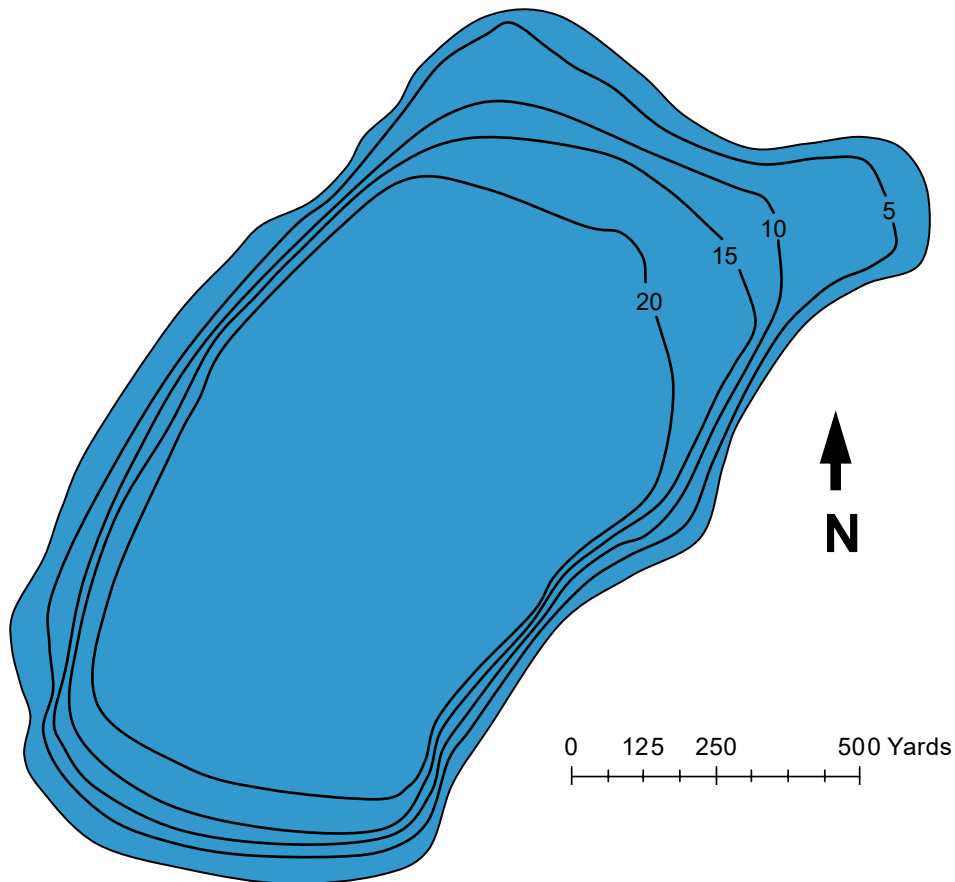

Portage to and paddle across Canoe Lake #1, #2, and #3, Contact, Marten, Spruce, Otter, Rock, Loon, Clam, and Moosehorn Lakes. Swan Lake Canoe Area is designated wilderness. No motorized equipment or vehicles. Please pack out litter.
