

<u>Lake Public Access</u>: Mile 83.4 Sterling Hwy, 16 miles north on Swanson River Road, 9.5 miles east on Swan Lake Road. East Entrance to Swan Lake Canoe Trails has parking area with toilets and trailhead register. Paddle across Portage Lake, then portage to and paddle across Birch, Teal, Mallard, and Raven lakes to Swan Lake. Alternate route from West Entrance to Swan Lake Canoe Trails, starting at Canoe Lake #1. Swan Lake Canoe Area is designated wilderness. No motorized equipment or vehicles. Please pack out litter.
