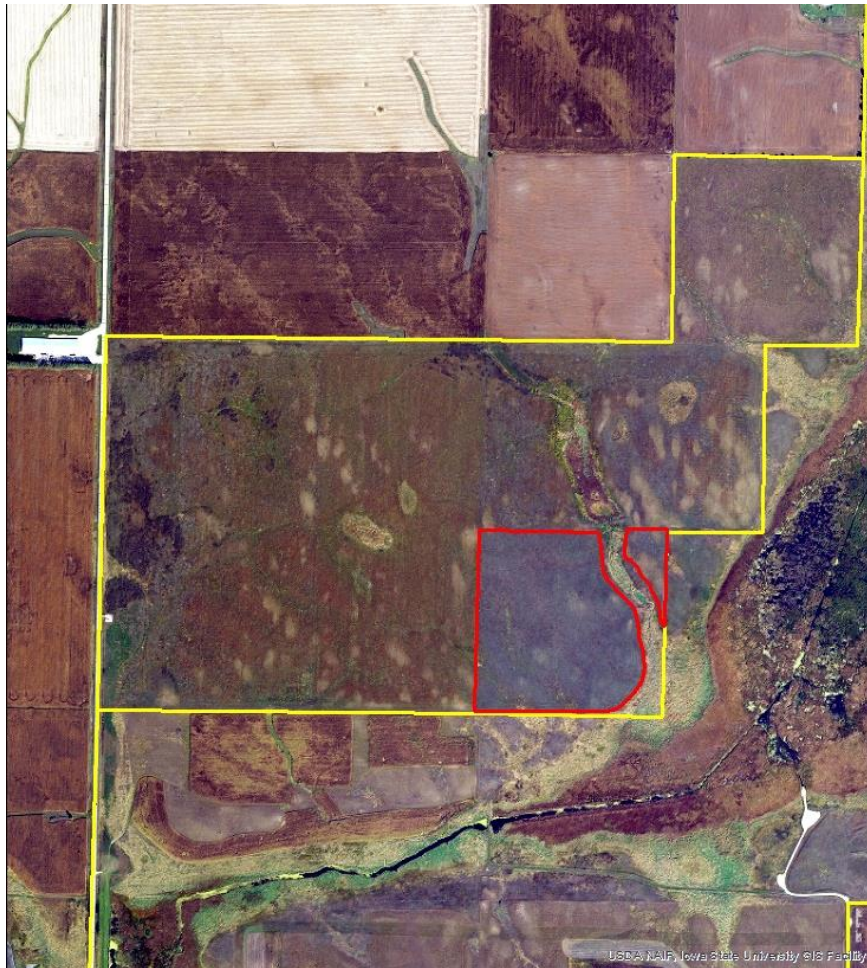

1. Fields designated as row crop will be planted using untreated and non –GMO seed. It is the responsibility of the cooperator to use the correct seed. Designated crop fields will be delayed harvest; these fields will be designated Sept. 1. These fields may be harvested after March 1. **In 2024 and 2025 there will be 3.3 acres delay harvest.**
2. The cooperator will use end rows on all crop fields. Care shall be taken when spraying Roundup on row crops, so as not to kill adjacent cover. Field marker post and field boundaries shall be respected; field size shall not increase.
3. Field #1 shall be plowed prior to seeding row crop each year.
4. Acreage figures appearing in the lease may not be the basis for federal farm program payments. It shall be the cooperators responsibility to determine the extent of the farm program benefits that are available.
5. Only herbicides from the pre-approved list may be used.
6. Neonicotinoids are prohibited (treated seed)
7. Insecticide use is prohibited.
8. Fall tillage is not allowed.
