The Friends of Rydell and Glacial Ridge Refuges Association and the Agassiz Environmental Learning Center (AELC) plan to select and support a shared **Visitor Services Intern** for up to a 13-week period, beginning sometime between early May and early June. Primary visitor services duties include: environmental education and interpretation, administering tours and special programs, providing social media and website content, and visitor center staffing. Additional work will include assisting U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service (USFWS) staff and AELC staff with habitat management, biological monitoring, and general maintenance activities. The intern will also have the opportunity to attend a 1-week USFWS Midwest Intern Workshop.

The stipend for this 40-hr/week internship will be \$400/week. Some weekend work may be required. Free housing in the Rydell National Wildlife Refuge Bunkhouse will be provided.
